10 Trip or Weekly Tap and Ride cards are available at bus interchanges and on board buses.
When you board a bus, you simply...tap and ride.



1 Each time you board a
bus, tap your card on
the card reader next to
the bus driver.



2 Hold the card steady until you hear a beep.
This beep means the fare has been
deducted. The screen will also display a
message that the fare has been deducted.



3 Take a seat and
enjoy the ride.
No need to tap 'off'
when you exit the bus.
